Walking / Jogging / Cycling



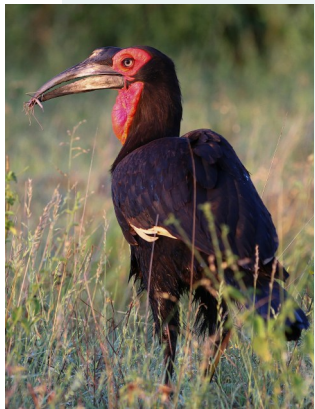
Mabula Private Game Reserve, a BIG 5 reserve, hosts potentially dangerous wildlife.

There is no cleaning service on Sundays and Public Holidays.

The speed limit is 30km/h.

Conservation fee is paid at the BushTime office for each vehicle entering Mabula.

No self-drives are permitted on Mabula. All guests have to make use of the formal guided safaris.

This is a game reserve; please respect the privacy and peace of other guests. Noise of any kind and the causing of disturbance to others are not permitted at any time. This rule will be strictly enforced, and transgressors will be dealt with accordingly by means of fines and or be asked to vacate the premises. No loud music is allowed anywhere on Mabula.
